GENERAL INFORMATION

Age of Delegates:

SAIMUN is an event for secondary level/high school students only. The average age of those taking part is 15-18 years. Please contact the SAIMUN office if you are planning on bringing students younger than 15 years old. Those delegates new to SAIMUN are recommended to attend a briefing for new delegates on the Monday morning of the event.

Country Assignment:

A maximum of two countries will be assigned to each school. In the event of there being extra availability, countries will be assigned on a first-come-first-served basis. The assigned countries will be emailed to participating schools by the end of November 2019.

Delegation Size:

Delegations will be a ***minimum of four students*** and a maximum of six (7 if allocated country has representation on Security Council or ECOSOC and 8 if representation on both). Three seats per delegation will be reserved on the floor of the General Assembly. Delegates should be trained to operate independently without consultation from Advisors during Committees or General Assembly.

Press:

A full Press corps consisting of a number of journalists, under the direction of a Press Coordinator, will produce a daily newspaper responsible for covering the event in all aspects. If you have students who wish to join the press team, please complete the online press form.

Photographs and Video:

The SAIMUN Press team and other conference participants may be filming and taking photographs of participants at our conference. Students and advisors attending the conference may feature in photographs or films published at the conference or on a St. Andrew's College website or social media account. St. Andrew's College does not have control over the use of photographs by other conference attendees.

Advisors:

It is important that teachers/advisors attend the conference and monitor the progress of their delegations. Those new to SAIMUN are recommended to attend the briefing for new advisors on the Monday morning of the event.

Visas:

Please apply for Visas in good time for students who may require them. If you are changing flights in another country please ensure the visa obtained is valid.
